

Minister: No licences for foreign broadcasters

Zimbabwe will not allow foreigners to own broadcasting stations but could relax rules and licences for locals who have been battling to meet stringent requirements, the information minister said on Monday.

Harare - "On the issue of ownership we cannot compromise," Information Minister Sikhanyiso Ndlovu told a committee of lawmakers.

"Why should a foreigner want to own a voice in Zimbabwe? The government policy on broadcasting seeks to achieve strategic goals. We seek to expose those we perceive as adversaries and win over those we see as useful allies.
