RIP Brendan Boyle

NEWSWATCH: Veteran journalist and editor Brendan Boyle passed away on Sunday night, according to a report on *Times Live*.

Former editor of the *Daily Dispatch*, bureau chief of Reuters South Africa and past executive editor of the *Sunday Times*, Boyle was apparently diagnosed with cancer about 18 months ago, according to a tweet by member of Parliament Corné Mulder.

He had a long-spanning career in the media industry and worked as a parliamentary correspondent for Reuters before he was promoted to head the agency's South African bureau.

Boyle also reportedly sent his CV as part of an application for a Democratic Alliance MP post after leaving the newspaper industry. The application was later withdrawn and Boyle continued to worked as a policy researcher, particularly on land issues.
